City on a Hill does not have an entrance exam; students are admitted by lottery with new students admitted in the 9th grade only. City on a Hill welcomes students with diverse learning needs (including those who may have a disability, require support services, or are English language learners) and will provide necessary accommodations and support services.

Any student who meets the following criteria may apply:

- **The student is a resident of Massachusetts**
- **The student will have successfully completed the 8th grade prior to attending City on a Hill**
Preference will be given to siblings of current students and to students from Boston.
