Any student who meets the following criteria may apply:

- The student is a resident of Massachusetts
- The student will have successfully completed the 8th grade prior to attending City on a Hill Preference will be given to siblings of current students and to students from New Bedford.

Applications must be received by 7/14/2019 at 11:59 PM to be included in initial lottery. The lottery will be held on 7/15/2019.
